

What to look for in over 65 travel insurance packs?

Previously it was not very unusual for insurance companies to charge high amounts as premiums for people who are aged beyond age 65. Some companies were also denying coverage for people who are aged over 65, but things have changed these days. There are several insurance companies who specialize in selling over 65 travel insurance policies both online and offline.

There are annual multi-trip and single trip policies available for people who are aged over 65 years. Multi-trip packs come with varying duration of allowance for each trip. In most cases it is 45 days, it can also be extended beyond with some little underwriting and paper works.

With the lot of free access to information relating to find the right kind of over 65 travel insurance policy online the purchase is made even easy. A well studied over 65 travel insurance can be purchased from the comfort of one's home. Despite being over 65 if you are that exceptionally healthy person you can seek discounts or concessions for your good health without medical proofs.

Some of the things that would contribute to the amount of premium that your policy would require are based on:-

- Whether one chooses a single trip or multi trip package
- Individual or group over 65 packages for couples
- The destination of travel
- The number of flights or cruise trips one is likely to take
- Based on the existing medical ailments
- The price of the package is dependent upon the comprehensiveness and extra benefits that is required.

Some of the things to look for in over 65 travel insurance packs are:-

- Normally winter sports and ski cover is not allowed beyond a certain age. If you need them you need to speak to the company regarding terms and conditions.
- Some polices would pay the claims directly to the hospital that treats you if the medical expenses happen during the trip; while some may require you to pay and have it reimbursed when you are back.
- Look in to make sure that your policy offers medical evacuation and repatriation.
- Most of the over 65 travel insurance policies require higher deductibles; check if they are affordable as there could be a better deal with other companies if the current one does not favor it.
- See if the company offers 24 hours toll free call assistance in the region where you travel.
